Moveable Feast Privacy Incident

Baltimore, Maryland – On March 20, 2024, Moveable Feast identified an isolated privacy incident that affected limited client information.

Moveable Feast discovered that documents containing client information were inadvertently placed in a recycling bin instead of a secure shred bin, in unintentional violation of our established information security and privacy policies. The recycling bin was awaiting curb pickup when wind overturned the bin and scattered its contents, including the documents containing client information.

Upon learning of the incident, Moveable Feast staff immediately collected the scattered documents; however, several pages containing client information were unable to be retrieved. The missing pages included client number, name, gender, race, and age for a subset of Moveable Feast clients. For a small number of those affected, last 4 of SSN was also included on the report. Full Social Security numbers, credit card information, financial information and medical information were <u>not</u> printed and thus not compromised. This incident did not involve any electronic information or system access.

At this time Moveable Feast is not aware of any evidence that client data was obtained or misused as a result of the incident; however, in an abundance of caution, the affected clients have been notified and offered a year of identity protection services. Additionally, Moveable Feast has retrained its staff to prevent privacy incidents in the future.
