CULINARY TRAINING PROGRAM

12 weeks of training in basic culinary skills, life-skills, resume building and job search strategies, ServSafe sanitation, safety training and hands-on-experience in commercial kitchen food production.

Instruction is provided by an experienced Chef, a certified ServSafe instructor, in coordination with Moveable Feast's Executive Chef, the Director of Food Services and their staff. Non-culinary topics are provided by specialists both in-house at Moveable Feast and from the community.

The course begins by **instilling vital food and kitchen safety habits**. Each student is required to pass an industry accredited food safety exam and become a certified safe food handler in order to advance.

Fundamental cooking methods and techniques along with essential kitchen terminology, sound knife skills, baking/pastry introduction, and menu planning serve to round out the Culinary Training Program.



APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS:

- Demonstrate a commitment to a career in the food industry
 - Must have a high school diploma or GED
 - Must be at least 18 years old
 - Demonstrate at least 3 months of being clean, sober and free of drugs/alcohol
 - Must have a working telephone contact and a permanent address
 - Successfully complete an initial interview
 - Commit to attending every day of the 12-week program
 - Pass a screening process, which includes:
 - basic reasoning and math skills test
 - drug screen
 - background check
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- *Lunch will be provided each training day*
 - *Black shirt pants and work shoes are required*
 - *Students with perfect attendance are granted a \$25 stipend each week*
